In this role, she was responsible for auditing and assessing estate tax returns filed with the division, as well as reviewing all estate planning documentation accompanying the returns to ensure accuracy and compliance with all state and federal laws.

Before being promoted to Chief of the Estate and Gift Tax Department, she served as a senior legal counsel representing the division in all phases of contested tax liabilities (including cases involving sales and use tax, cigarette and tobacco tax and corporate tax audit), in addition to those challenging the state's ability to impose tax obligations on out-of-state retailers. She also served as the division's Keeper of the Records and liaison with various state and federal agencies, fostering joint investigations into alleged tax evasion, money laundering, false claims litigation and various other financial investigations. Ms. Kelly received her juris doctor from Roger Williams University School of Law and her masters of laws degree in taxation from Boston University School of Law's Graduate Tax Program.

While in law school, she was a member of the honors program and law review. She served on the law review editorial board as an articles editor in her final year of law school and was the recipient of the CALI Excellence for the Future Award in both international law and trial advocacy. Ms. Kelly received a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from the University of Delaware.


